- ❑ **Cinquante** (Fifty)
- ❑ **Soixante** (Sixty)
- ❑ **Soixante-dix** (Seventy)
- ❑ **Quatre-vingts** (Eighty)
- ❑ **Quatre-vingt-dix** (Ninety)
- ❑ **Cent** (One hundred/hundred)
- ❑ **Mille** (One thousand/thousand)

### Quelques prepositions (Some prepositions)

- ❑ **Dans** (In) - **Je suis dans la maison** (I am in the house)
- ❑ **Sur** (On) - **Le chat est sur la table** (The cat is on the table)
- ❑ **Sous** (Under) - **Le chien est sous la table** (The dog is under the table)
- ❑ **Devant** (In front of) - **Nous sommes devant le cinéma** (We are in front of the cinema)
- ❑ **Derrière** (Behind) - **Nous allons derrière la voiture** (We are going behind the car)
