The Weather - Y Tywydd

Sut mae'r tywydd heddiw? - What's the weather like today?

Mae hi'n braf heddiw - I t's fine today

Yn and 'n trigger a Soft Mutation (Treiglad Meddal) in words that start with the letter P, T, C, B, D, G, Ll, M or Rh. Braf is the exception and does not mutate after yn.

You will often hear people say Mae'n instead of Mae hi'n, when conversing in Welsh. Either is acceptable.

Mae hi'n oer - I t's cold

Mae hi'n dwym - I t's hot

Mae hi'n wyntog - I t's windy

Mae hi'n sych - I t's dry

Mae hi' wlyb - I t's wet

Mae hi'n neis - I t's nice

Mae hi'n ddiflas - I t's miserable

Mae hi'n bwrw glaw - I t's raining

Mae hi'n bwrw cesair – I t's hailing
Mae hi'n bwrw eira – I t's snowing

The words that we heard mutating in episode 10 are:

Twym (hot) to dwym; Gwyntog (windy) to wyntog; Gwlyb (wet) to wlyb; and Diflas (miserable) to ddiflas.

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
